Minutes of a meeting held on Zoom at 6pm on Monday 13 September 2021

- 3. Minutes of the meeting held on 16 August 2021 were approved. Action: Mel will post on website
- 4. David H reported that he has submitted a Stage one application for a grant from Viridor Credits, who will next meet on 7 January 2022 to consider full part 2 applications. They would fund up to half the costs of land purchase and necessary accompanying groundworks. If we applied and were approved, we would have to draw down the money within 6 months. We could defer until March (they have quarterly meetings), giving us until Sept 2022 to draw funds, but no later than that. We debated the pros and cons of applying in January or March, in relation to current PWLB borrowing rates, and the possible results of our local appeal. At present the group favours a March 2022 application.

Post meeting update 20 9 21: following further consultation with Viridor and Devon Association of Local Councils, it is clear that our better option is to proceed with Stage 2 application now, for the Jan 7, 2022 deadline.

5. Nick B reported that joint fund raising leaflets had been distributed to every household by members of the two working groups with an address list circulated by ML; and that 45 packs containing printed prospectus brochures had been delivered to potential early supporters and those requesting further information.
