Please if you have any of the cloth bags can you return them when you are next passing so we have them for other customers, There are literally hundreds around the village and beyond, that Janet and her willing band of sewers have made for us and we could do with them back as one day we had not a single one to use. Thank you also to Jane W for donating more material for us to make more bags.

Would you like to help your community shop without it costing you a single penny? You can do this by using the Post Office for all your banking needs as the Post Office has greatly increased the amount it pays us for transactions like paying in and drawing out money. It has also increased the rate of commission we receive on posted parcels etc. So, save yourself the hassle of a trip into town, parking worries and fuel costs. Every little extra we receive makes a big difference in these challenging times and will cost you nothing extra but is a gain to the shop and our community.
