Report from Brenda Mosedale Defibrillator Warden

At the defibrillator training session on 5th September, Shillingford shared that they have produced a card which lets everyone in the village know the code number for their defibrillator.

My understanding is that when IDE's was installed the advice was not to make the code public on the basis that if you didn't need to ring 999 for the code then you might forget to ring 999 at all - which is the first thing you should do.

The trainer could see both points of view but there have been voices in the village about the code number being made available to people - so my question quite simply is whether the Parish Council might want to consider this question again. I am not advocating one course of action over another.

If there were a decision for the code number to be more widely known then the follow up question would be how that might be done.
